Dr. Friman received his Ph.D. from the University of Kansas. He is the current Vice President of Behavioral Health at Boys Town and a Clinical Professor in the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Nebraska School of Medicine. He is the former Editor of the Journal of Applied Behavior Analysis and former President of the Association for Behavior Analysis International. He is currently on the editorial boards of six peer reviewed journals and has published more than 190 scientific articles and 3 book chapters.





Dr. Kazemi received her doctorate from UCLA. Her mission is to conduct experimental research that leads to improvements in education, training, and supervised experience of caregivers (parents, teachers, and behavior technicians) who implement behavior plans with clients. Her recent lines of research involve 1) finding efficient, effective training and supervision strategies and 2) using humanoid robots to simulate clients with learning and behavioral problems in training and research. As a professor at California State University, Northridge she has been recognized each of the past 8 years with multiple awards for outstanding teaching, service, and mentorship.
